### Pause to Pray for Others - and Tell Them A Personal Story

A little over a week ago our son underwent a Lithotripsy, a procedure using shock waves to break up a large kidney stone that he had been carrying for several months. Due to the size of the stone a stent was inserted during the procedure to enable the fragments to more easily pass from his body. A couple of mornings later, he began to experience excruciating pain, later determined to be caused by clogging of the stent. We were called in to help with the children so our son's wife could drive him to the ER. We immediately sent out a prayer request to the Prayer Ministry large group list of about 120 people. Within minutes we began receiving emails and texts from people with words of encouragement and promises to pray, even from as far away as Texas! This continued for the next couple of days. Words can't possibly express how deeply we have been touched by this outpouring of love, concern and compassion, and how God worked in bringing healing to our son in answer to the prayers of so many. All this to encourage you, when you receive requests to pray, when possible, to take a minute or two to send off an email or text, or even pick up the phone, and let the person in need know that you are praying for them. This added personal touch will encourage and strengthen their hearts and will bring joy to your own soul. This past week we truly saw one picture of the church being the church and were impacted greatly, as were our son and his family. - Blessings, M & M
