Luke 3:23-38

I. The name Jesus means, **the Lord is Salvation**. (Jehovah)

Matthew 1:21 – She will give birth to a son, and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins. (CSB)

Colossians 2:9 – For the entire fullness of God’s nature dwells bodily in Christ, (CSB)

Philippians 2:10-11 – ¹⁰so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow— in heaven and on earth and under the earth— ¹¹and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (CSB)

II. The name Christ means, **anointed one**.

Daniel 9:25 – Know and understand this: From the issuing of the decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until an Anointed One, the ruler, will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks. It will be rebuilt with a plaza and a moat, but in difficult times. (CSB)

Hebrews 1:9 – You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; this is why God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of joy beyond your companions. (CSB)

III. Jesus is our **King**.

John 18:37 – “You are a king then?” Pilate asked. “You say that I’m a king,” Jesus replied. “I was born for this, and I have come into the world for this: to testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice.” (CSB)

Revelation 19:16 – And he has a name written on his robe and on his thigh: King of Kings and Lord of Lords. (CSB)
