

Jesus Is Your Divine Deliverer
Luke 4:31-44

James 1:4 – And let endurance have its full effect, so that you may be mature and complete, lacking nothing. (CSB)

I. Know what is **fantasy** and know what is **fact**.

John 8:44 – You are of your father the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he tells a lie, he speaks from his own nature, because he is a liar and the father of lies. (CSB)

II. The presence of Jesus in your life brings **power** and **significance**.

1 Corinthians 1:26, 30-31 – ²⁶Brothers and sisters, consider your calling: Not many were wise from a human perspective, not many powerful, not many of noble birth. ³⁰It is from him that you are in Christ Jesus, who became wisdom from God for us—our righteousness, sanctification, and redemption, ³¹in order that, as it is written: Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord. (CSB)

Being delivered by Jesus brings:

Redemption

Righteousness

Justified

Sanctified

A. Jesus delivers you by His **preaching**.

Luke 4:32 – They were astonished at his teaching because his message had authority. (CSB)

John 14:10 – Don't you believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words I speak to you I do not speak on my own. The Father who lives in me does his works. (CSB)

B. Jesus delivers you through His **purpose**.

Luke 4:33-37 – ³³In the synagogue there was a man with an unclean demonic spirit who cried out with a loud voice, ³⁴“Leave us alone! What do you have to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!” ³⁵But Jesus rebuked him and said, “Be silent and come out of him!” And throwing him down before them, the demon came out of him without hurting him at all. ³⁶Amazement came over them all, and they were saying to one another, “What is this message? For he commands the unclean spirits with authority and power, and they come out!” ³⁷And news about him began to go out to every place in the vicinity. (CSB)

1 John 3:8 – The one who commits sin is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God was revealed for this purpose: to destroy the devil's works. (CSB)

C. Jesus delivers you in His **power**.

Luke 4:38-40 – ³⁸After he left the synagogue, he entered Simon's house. Simon's mother-in-law was suffering from a high fever, and

they asked him about her. ³⁹So he stood over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. She got up immediately and began to serve them. ⁴⁰When the sun was setting, all those who had anyone sick with various diseases brought them to him. As he laid his hands on each one of them, he healed them. (CSB)

Acts 10:38 – how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how he went about doing good and healing all who were under the tyranny of the devil, because God was with him. (CSB)

D. Jesus delivers you to His **place**.

Luke 4:41-43 – ⁴¹Also, demons were coming out of many, shouting and saying, “You are the Son of God!” But he rebuked them and would not allow them to speak, because they knew he was the Christ. ⁴²When it was day, he went out and made his way to a deserted place. But the crowds were searching for him. They came to him and tried to keep him from leaving them. ⁴³But he said to them, “It is necessary for me to proclaim the good news about the kingdom of God to the other towns also, because I was sent for this purpose.” (CSB)

Colossians 1:13 – He has rescued us from the domain of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of the Son he loves. (CSB)

Romans 8:37 – No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. (CSB)
